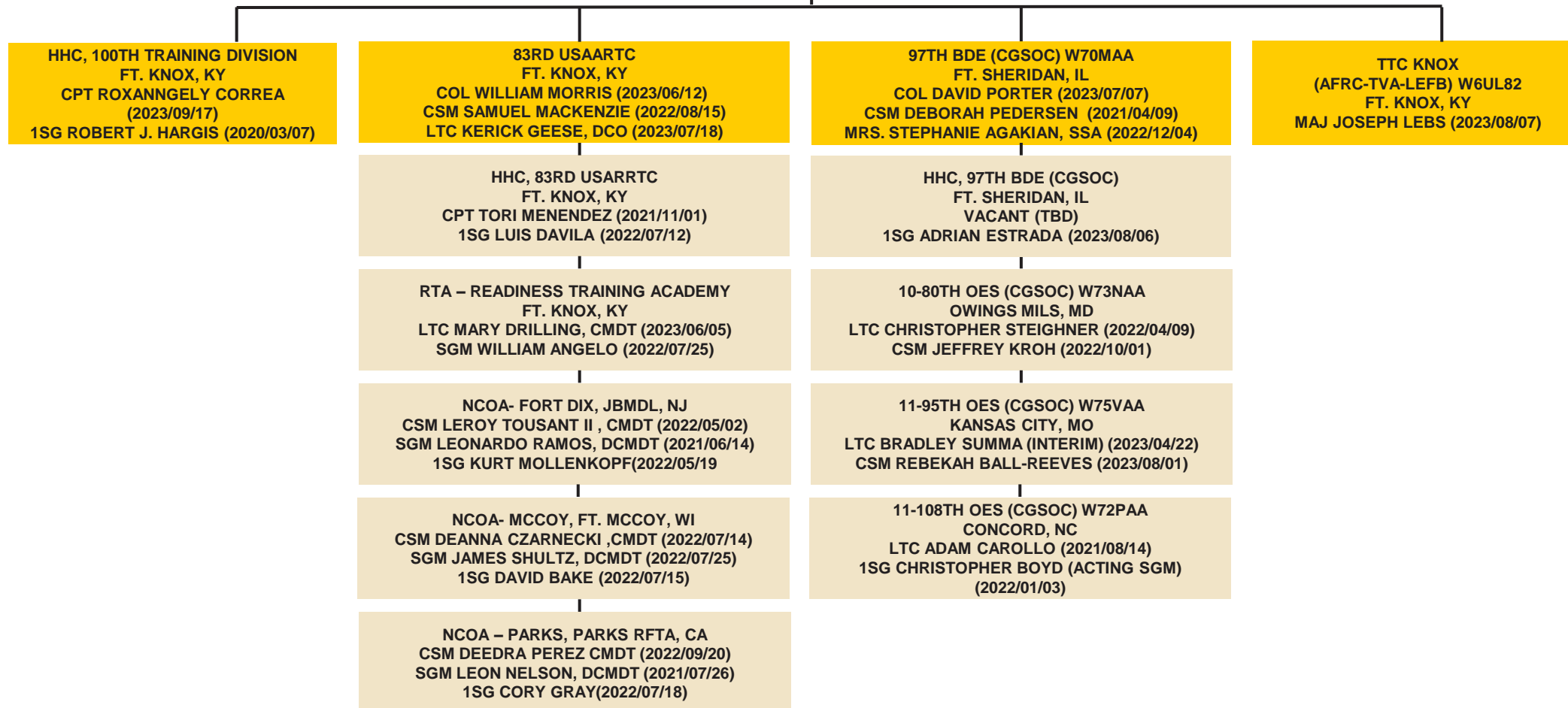

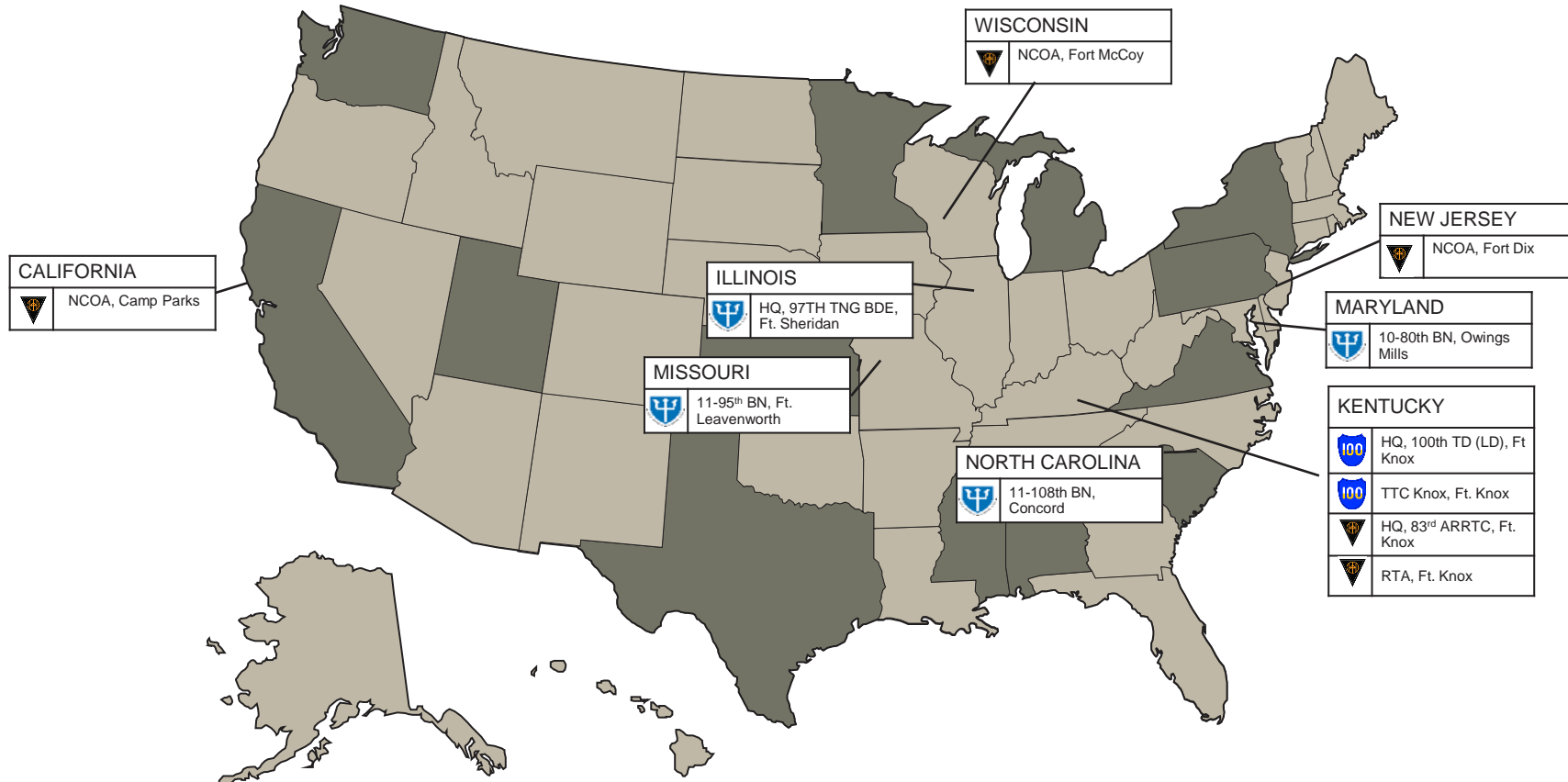

100TH TD (LD) MISSION STATEMENT



MISSION STATEMENT:

Provides Command and Control functions and coordinating and special staff for The Army School System (TASS) Brigades, and to personnel assigned to this unit. During peacetime provides a full range of command, Support, and management functions for assigned brigades and other assigned units, including but not limited to Military Occupation Specialty Training and the Technical Phases of Non Commissioned Officer Training. The Division is responsible for the accreditation of assigned TASS Battalions. The 100th Division commands a total of two (2) Brigades of which two are functionally aligned with TRADOC Proponent Schools. The other detachment, TASS Training Center (TTC) Knox is a USAR unit which has been recognized to have valid Full Time unit support staff or Military Technician requirements. Personnel and equipment remain under the command and responsibility of USAR commanders. USAR Military Technicians perform day-to-day functions pertaining to operations, training, administration and logistics. The command and staff of the division interact with other components of the military and directly with the proponent schools to ensure the most current information is taught to the students. The Division also conducts annual Program of Instruction (POI) reviews. The Division provides funding guidance to the Brigades, and coordinates directly with the 80th Training Command (TASS) concerning policies, programs, actions, and procedures. These areas include, but are not limited to, the areas of personnel management, operations, training, logistics management, comptroller activities, information management, physical/personnel/information security, chaplain, medical, legal activities, inspector general activities, and internal review.

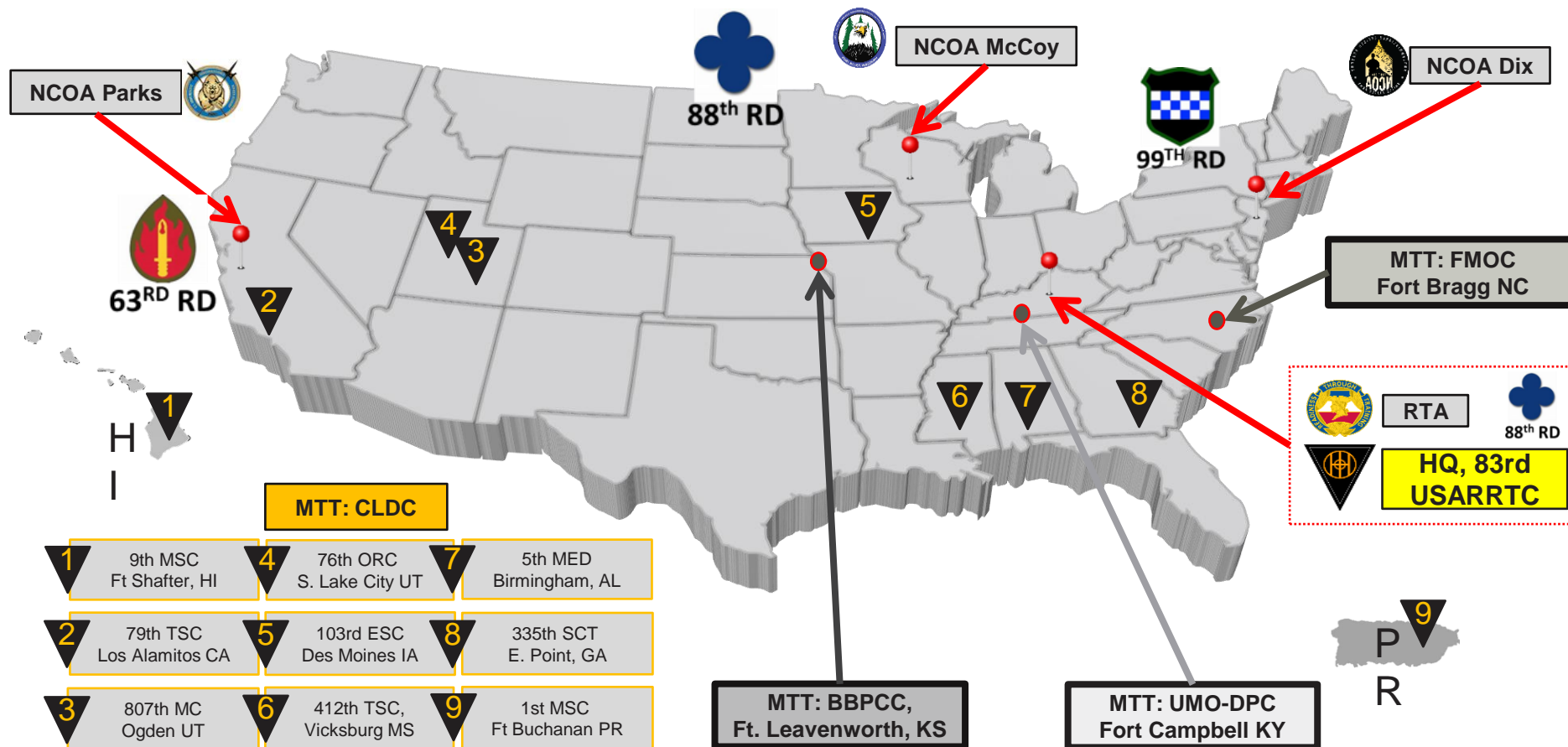
During mobilization provides instructors and other personnel to augment Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) proponent schools.
