

# First Army Division East



First Army is the Responsible Command designated by the United States Army Forces Command for Enabling Reserve Component Readiness and Conducting Mobilization Operations supporting global operations.

## Our Organization:

- *Division East Headquarters was activated March 7th, 2007.*
- *Coordinating Authority spans 39 states and employs over 3,300 Soldiers and civilians with 1 Brigade Headquarters stationed on Fort Knox*
- *Fort Knox is designated as 1 of 5 Mobilization Force Generating Installations supporting Large Scale Mobilization Operations in Division East*
- *The only Division currently commanded by a Kentucky Army National Guard General Officer.*

## Increasing Readiness:

- The **National Guard and Reserve Component filled 16% (~50,000 Soldiers) of ALL US Army forces deployed** in Fiscal Year 2023.
- The **National Guard and Reserve Component is expected to fill 20% (~45,000 Soldiers) of ALL US Army forces deploying** in Fiscal Year 2024.
