First Army is the <u>Responsible Command</u> designated by the United States Army Forces Command for <u>Enabling</u> <u>Reserve Component Readiness</u> and <u>Conducting Mobilization Operations</u> supporting global operations.





Our Organization:

- Division East Headquarters was activated March 7th, 2007.
- Coordinating Authority spans 39 states and employs over 3,300 Soldiers and civilians with 1 Brigade Headquarters stationed on Fort Knox
- Fort Knox is designated as 1 of 5 Mobilization Force Generating Installations supporting Large Scale Mobilization Operations in Division East
- The only Division currently commanded by a Kentucky Army National Guard General Officer.

Increasing Readiness:

- The National Guard and Reserve Component filled 16% (~50,000 Soldiers) of ALL US Army forces deployed in Fiscal Year 2023.
- The National Guard and Reserve Component is expected to fill 20% (~45,000 Soldiers) of ALL US Army forces deploying in Fiscal Year 2024.
