**MPSA**

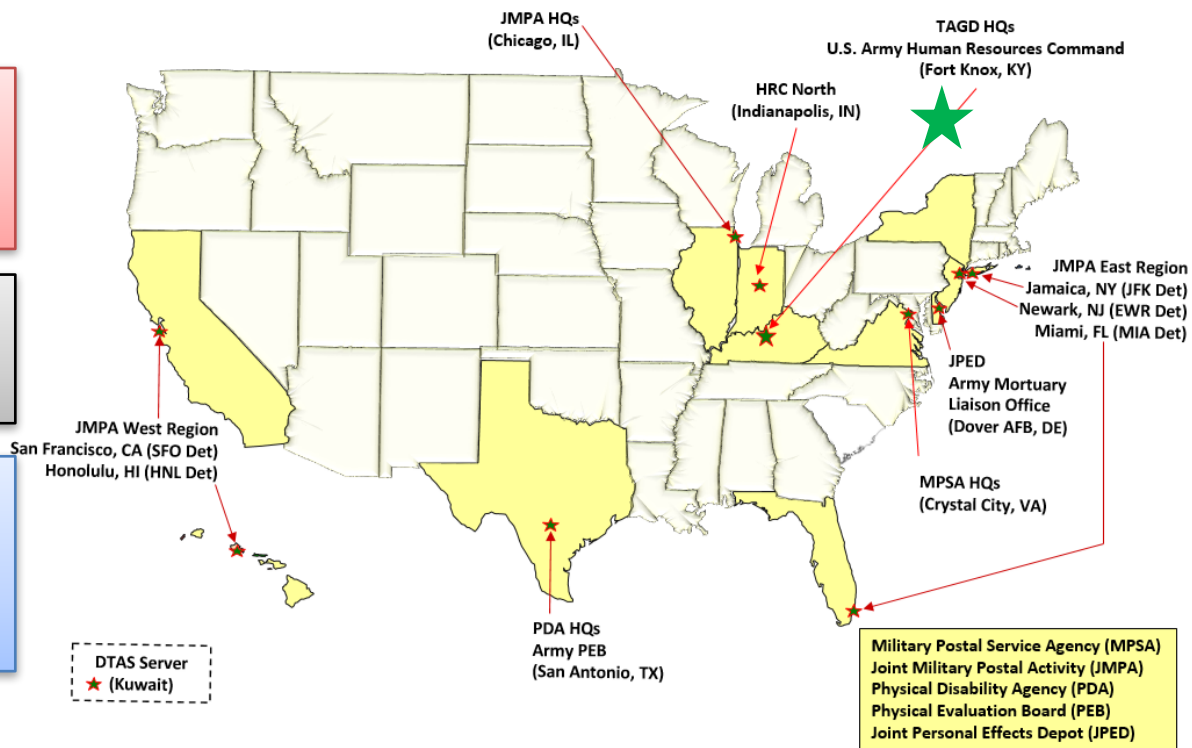


Achieve efficient and responsive processing, transportation, and distribution of personal and official mail within DoD.

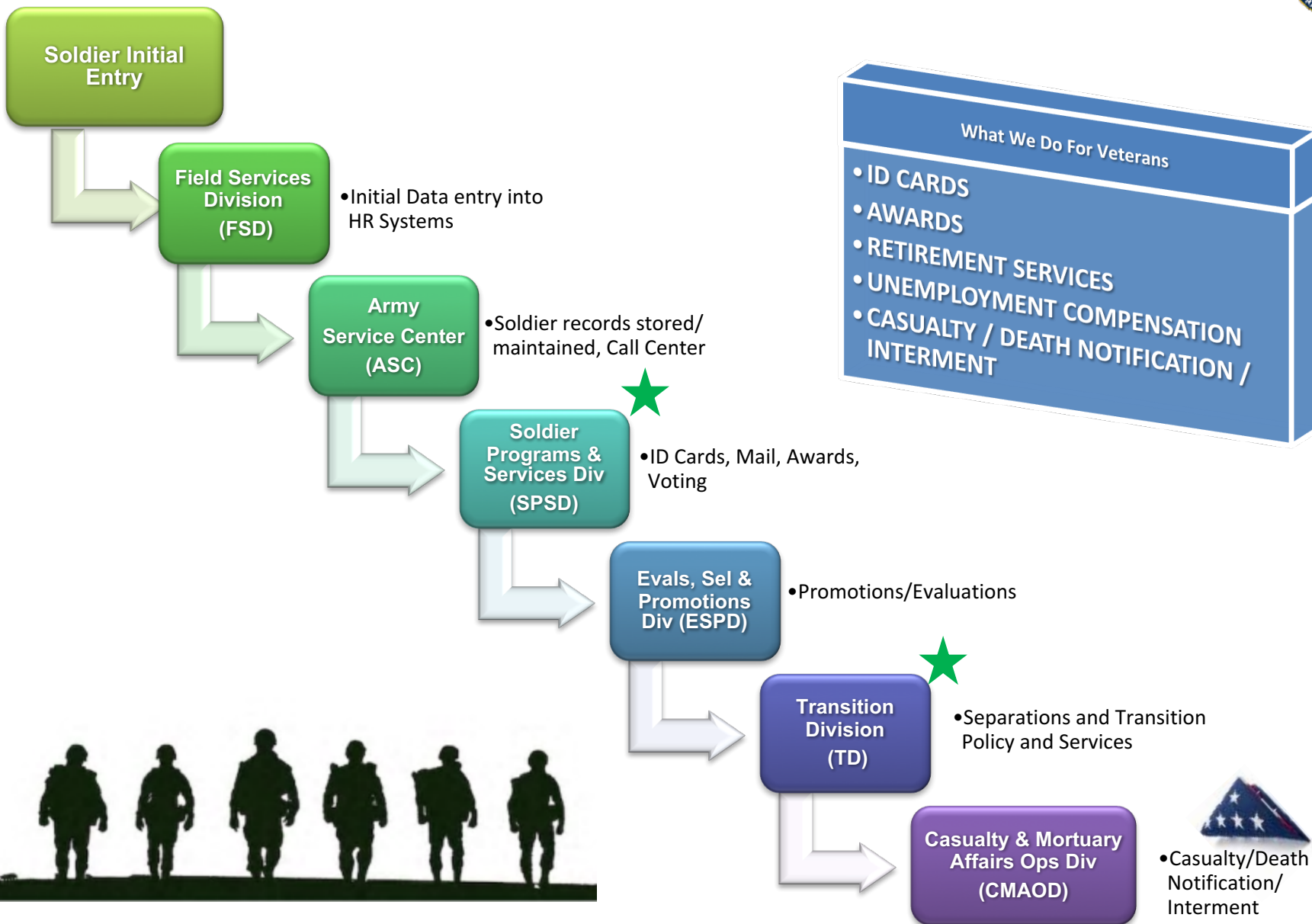
- **The Adjutant General Directorate (TAGD), the Military Postal Service Agency (MPSA), and the U.S. Army Physical Disability Agency (PDA) combine for over 1,000 personnel (Service Members, DoD Civilians, & Contractors) with 700+ personnel working at Fort Knox, KY**
- **Fiscal Year 2021 Highlights:**
  - Combat Related Special Compensation – processed over \$765 million worth of claims
  - Army Postal Service – processed / transported over 35 million pounds of mail
  - Voter Assistance – provided over 192,000 Federal Post Card Applications (CY)
  - Awards – processed over 9,000 actions

# The Adjutant General Directorate Highlights



- **Transition and the Career Skills Program**
  - Installation Management Command runs program
  - Kentucky's part: 14 programs at Fort Campbell; 4 programs at Fort Knox
  - CONUS wide, 93% placement rate
- **Unemployment Compensation**
  - Retirees make up 22.9% of the claimant population for FY21 (down 3% from FY20)
  - Army UCX has received all KY Quarterly Billing Statements for FY21
  - Army Veteran unemployment claims continue to be less than 1% of KY's total unemployed population

- **Voting**
  - Small number of absentee voters for Kentucky
  - In the Military Postal System- Received requests for 587 absentee ballots; Postmarked and Dispatched 587 ballots in support of the last election cycle
